Terms and Conditions

- Science Olympiad Team teaching (first step) and competition team (second step) decisions are made by SO Committee and advisory committee that consist of Science teachers, school administrator and other FSA personnel. Event coaches will provide feedback on individual student performances but there is no parent in decision making process.
- Students' Science, Math and standardized test scores will be checked as well as discipline records during application and team selection process. **Team success has the priority over individual successes.**
- The previous experience in SO **does not** guarantee placement in SO.
- The number of qualified applicants, coach and room restrictions will determine the size of the SO team.
- Although some students are permitted to participate in some extra competitions the priority must be given to SO if accepted. After school activities/ clubs, sports competitions, scouts and such activities **cannot** replace SO weekday or weekend activities. Some provisions may apply to certain students who complete the work at home upon event coach's approval.
- Students will follow the instructions given by event coaches. Failure to do so will result in expulsion from SO team in three steps process.
- The first step for removal is warning verbally, the second is official warning to get on task and follow instructions or respect to other members and the coach. The third step is asking the student leave from the event or SO depending on the situation. Student can get back to team with SO committee's decision. In the meanwhile, students cannot join in any event or team teaching. An available team teaching will be assigned.
